General Rules

Kayaks & Paddleboards

Use at your own risk

While there is no official minimum age to operate a kayak or paddleboard independently, children under the age of 16 should be supervised by an adult while on the water. This is due to the potential for changing tides, rapid changing weather conditions, and boat traffic from the adjacent marina.

Child-sized kayaks are locked and require adult assistance to access. Adults are responsible for unlocking these kayaks and securing them after use to prevent unsupervised access by children.

Please rinse all equipment and return it to the designated rack before check out.

** If any equipment is damaged or missing, please notify Robert in the office before use so a replacement can be arranged. We do not have spare paddles on hand so don't lose them!*

Florida FWC Requirements:

- Life jackets (PFDs) are required for each person on board
- Children under 6 must wear a life jacket at all times
- A whistle or sound-producing device is required on all vessels
- Paddleboarders & Kayakers are considered vessel operators and must follow all boating navigation rules.
- Operating under the influence of alcohol or drugs is illegal.

Pool + Spa

Instructions

SPA

The spa controls are located on the pillar as you enter the pool area from the carport. The spa will run on an automatic 2-hour timer and shut off on its own (Please note it takes roughly 20-30 minutes to reach temperature). If you'd like more time, simply press the button again. The spa is pre-set to 100°F and cannot be adjusted without contacting maintenance.

Please note: When the spa is activated, the pool circulation and water features will pause automatically. These will resume once the spa shuts off.

POOL

If you would like the pool heated or cooled, please speak to Robert in the downstairs office at least 24 hours in advance. The pool system requires a full 24 hours to reach and maintain the desired temperature, and the heater or cooler must run continuously to keep the water consistent.

FEATURES

For additional control of spa and pool features, you can download the **Pentair Pool** app using the QR code provided.

- Select different light themes for the pool (lights turn on automatically at 8 PM and off at 1 AM)
- Turn the spa air blowers on or off
- Turn the deck fountains and bubbler on or off

Equipment



Emergency Evacuation



Trash Pickup:

- Trash Pickup Day: Tuesday & Saturday early morning
- Do not place trash at the curb before 6:00 PM the day prior to pickup
- Trash can must be placed on asphalt curb not blocking the driveway or mailbox.
- Trash may be put/dumped in the on-site dumpster if needed (absolutely no fishing waste, scraps, chum or chum bags in dumpster)

Guest Conduct:

- Monroe County Noise Ordinance: Quiet Hours between 10pm – 7am
- Guests may be cited, fined, or evicted for creating disturbances or violating any part of this ordinance.
